- p. 15 In caption to Figure 1-7, the words “blue” and “purple” are reversed (Adam Tyner).
- p. 30 Under the heading “Relation of Investment and Saving”, there is a period missing between the first two sentences (Nick Contag).
- p. 35 Four lines from bottom, 12.3 percent should be 12.4 percent (Rishi Taparia).
- p. 45 Line 6. “The box on p. 45” should be “The box on p. 44” (Peter Shih).
- p. 52 Problem 1, part (e). In the “hint” replace “‘transfer payments and interest’ in Table 2-1” by “‘interest and personal transfer payments’ on line 12 of Table 2-1” (Shyaam Ramkumar).
- p. 53 Self-test answer to p. 30, seven lines down, “inventory charge” should be “inventory change”.
